Excellent park facilities surround each shelter for groups to enjoy; however, please note that these amenities are not reserved as part of a picnic Park Rangers may stop by during a shelter rental to check permits and to ensure a safe and healthy environment. Reservations

Reservations for park shelters are taken beginning the first business day in October for the upcoming calendar year on a first come, first served basis.

Park shelters are available to rent from 10 am to 8 pm in the summer, 10 am to 6 pm in the off-season.

Park shelters are available on holidays. Regular rental rates apply.

Insurance may be required.

For weekend reservations made after 4 pm on the Thursday prior, condition of area is not guaranteed.

A requested date will be temporarily held. However, a completed contract must be signed and payment made within 3 business days from the date the tentative reservation was made. If this deadline is not met, the tentative reservation will be canceled and the date/location will be made available to other requestors.


Groups of more than 200 people must be approved by the parks division to receive a permit. There will be an additional "Large Group Fee." A Special Event permit may also be required.

A beer and wine permit is required if these beverages will be consumed at your event. A security deposit will be required with all beer and wine beverage permits.

Bounce houses and similar apparatus are not allowed unless a Special Event Permit has been issued.

Requests for use of amplified sound (including use of a DJ, mixing board, live band or sound amplifiers) will be reviewed on an individual basis. A Sound Amplification Permit or Special Event Permit is required. Amplified sound may be restricted to certain parks and times based upon the intended use and impact on others. Users may need to supply their own power generator.

Rules

Glass bottles or beverage containers are prohibited.

Shade canopies may be anchored by sand bags or water buckets only - stakes are prohibited.

Groups are required to clean up the shelter and immediate area after use. Penalty fees will be assessed if areas are damaged or need additional cleaning.

Support Items

Electricity, where available, is 110v/15amp.

Water jug fillers are available at Snowflake, Teglia's Paradise, Whitaker and Virginia Lake shelters. This is the only water available other than by drinking fountain.

Drinking fountains may be inoperapable during the off-season.

Refunds

CAPACITY

If reservations are canceled at least 30 days prior to the scheduled event, a full refund less an administrative fee will be given. There will be no refunds for reservations canceled with less than a 30 day notice.

Special Events

Per RMC 5.13, a Special Event Permit is required for, but not limited to, the following activities: Concerts • Parades • Fairs • Festivals • Entertainment • Arts & Craft Shows • Performances • Community Events • Sales of Food and Beverage • Public Dances • Traffic Disruption • Mass Participation Sports (running events, bicycle races) • Any event involving City Services (Police, Fire)
