## **Curbside Recycling**

If you live in a single residence home, call Waste Management Recycle America at 329-8822 to get your green and yellow curbside bins. If you live in an apartment complex, you can take recyclables to Waste Management Recycle America stations.

- Curbside recyclables include aluminum cans, steel cans, plastic bottles, green, brown, and clear glass bottles and jars.
- Newspaper can be recycled curbside in a brown paper bag.
- Old phone books can be placed on top of your curbside recyclables.

The following can be taken to Waste Management Recycle America stations:

- · Corrugated cardboard
- Office paper, including "junk mail"

NOT accepted at Recycle America:

- Blue, broken, or Pyrex glass
- Chipboard/paperboard (cereal boxes, etc.)
- Any plastic other than plastic bottles.
   Plastic bags can be taken to your local grocery store.
