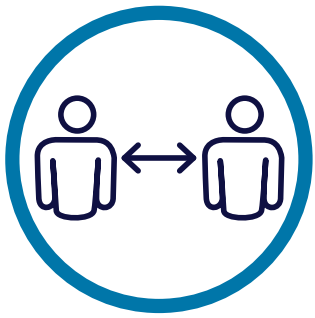


OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES FOR ESSENTIAL BUSINESSES

PROTECT YOUR EMPLOYEES AND CUSTOMERS



KEEP YOUR DISTANCE

- Maintain 6 feet of separation between people
- Mark standing areas to provide 6 feet of separation



PROHIBIT SELF-SERVE FOOD & BEVERAGE

- Prohibit self-serve food and beverage, including drinks, bulk items, condiments and samples



GLOVES, MASKS & SNEEZE SHIELDS

- Provide gloves and masks to all employees and require use for food handling, cleaning, cashiering, customer interactions, and cart retrieval
- Install "sneeze shields" at check stands or relocate pay stations to be 6 feet from employees



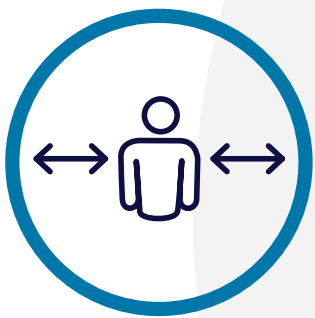
REDUCE BUILDING OCCUPANCY

- Limit building occupancy to no more than 50 percent
- Establish procedures to prevent the congregation of 10 people or more in any area



WASH YOUR HANDS

- Wash your hands with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds
- Provide alcohol-based hand sanitizer



MINIMIZE PERSONNEL INTERACTION

- Whenever possible, adopt contact-less payment systems
- Provide curbside, pick-up or delivery of goods whenever possible



FREQUENT CLEANING

- Clean and disinfect counters, tabletops, toilets, phones, keyboards, and door handles frequently throughout the day



CLOSE ON-SITE DINING, BAR & GAMING AREAS

- Close dining areas with physical barriers or by placing chairs on dining room tables
- Close all bar and lounge areas
- Close all gaming machines, devices, tables and games



STAY HOME IF YOU ARE SICK

- Employees must stay at home if sick



FOLLOW STATE DIRECTIVES

- Comply with Gov. Sisolak's Emergency Directives 003 & 013, and other guidance for essential businesses.
