

# OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES FOR ESSENTIAL BUSINESSES

# PROTECT YOUR EMPLOYEES AND CUSTOMERS



# **KEEP YOUR DISTANCE**

- Maintain 6 feet of separation
  between people
- Mark standing areas to provide 6 feet of separation



#### GLOVES, MASKS & SNEEZE SHIELDS

- Provide gloves and masks to all employees and require use for food handling, cleaning, cashiering, customer interactions, and cart retrieval
- Install "sneeze shields" at check stands or relocate pay stations to be 6 feet from employees



# MINIMIZE PERSONNEL

- Whenever possible, adopt contact-less payment systems
- Provide curbside, pick-up or delivery of goods whenever possible



#### CLOSE ON-SITE DINING, BAR & GAMING AREAS

- Close dining areas with physical barriers or by placing chairs on dining room tables
- Close all bar and lounge areas
- Close all gaming machines, devices, tables and games





#### PROHIBIT SELF-SERVE FOOD & BEVERAGE

• Prohibit self-serve food and beverage, including drinks, bulk items, condiments and samples

#### REDUCE BUILDING OCCUPANCY

- Limit building occupancy to no more than 50 percent
- Establish procedures to prevent the congregation of 10 people or more in any area

# WASH YOUR HANDS

- Wash your hands with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds
- Provide alcohol-based hand sanitizer

# FREQUENT CLEANING

 Clean and disinfect counters, tabletops, toilets, phones, keyboards, and door handles frequently throughout the day

#### STAY HOME IF YOU ARE SICK

• Employees must stay at home if sick

# FOLLOW STATE DIRECTIVES

• Comply with Gov. Sisolak's Emergency Directives 003 & 013, and other guidance for essential businesses



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
