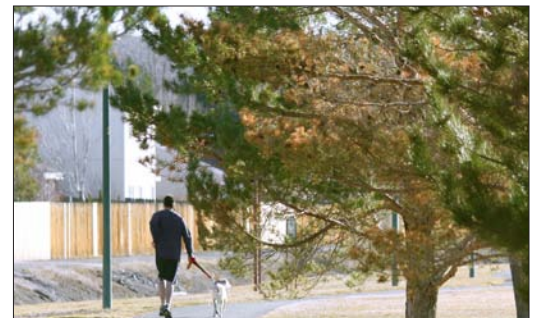
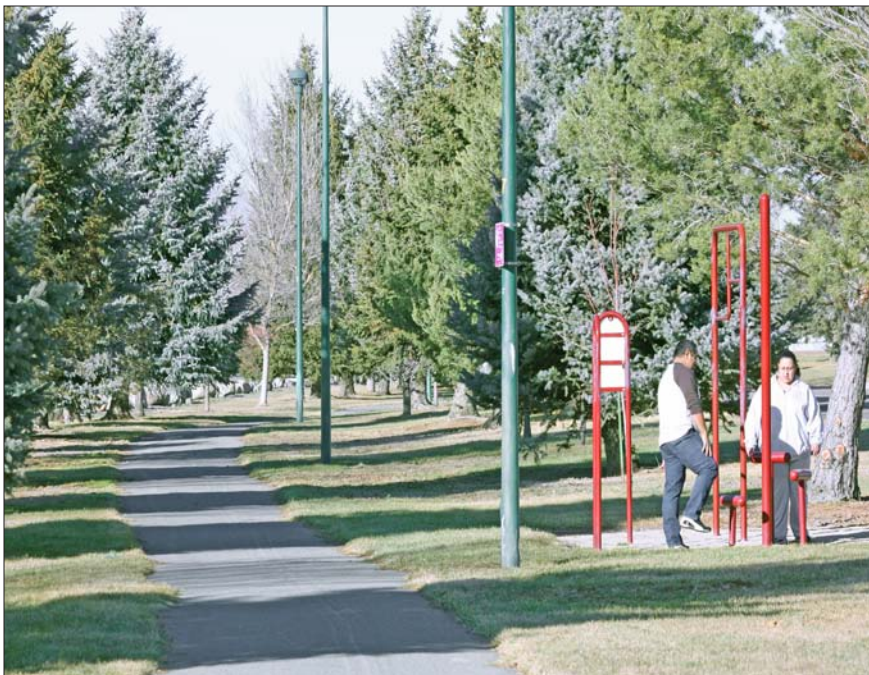
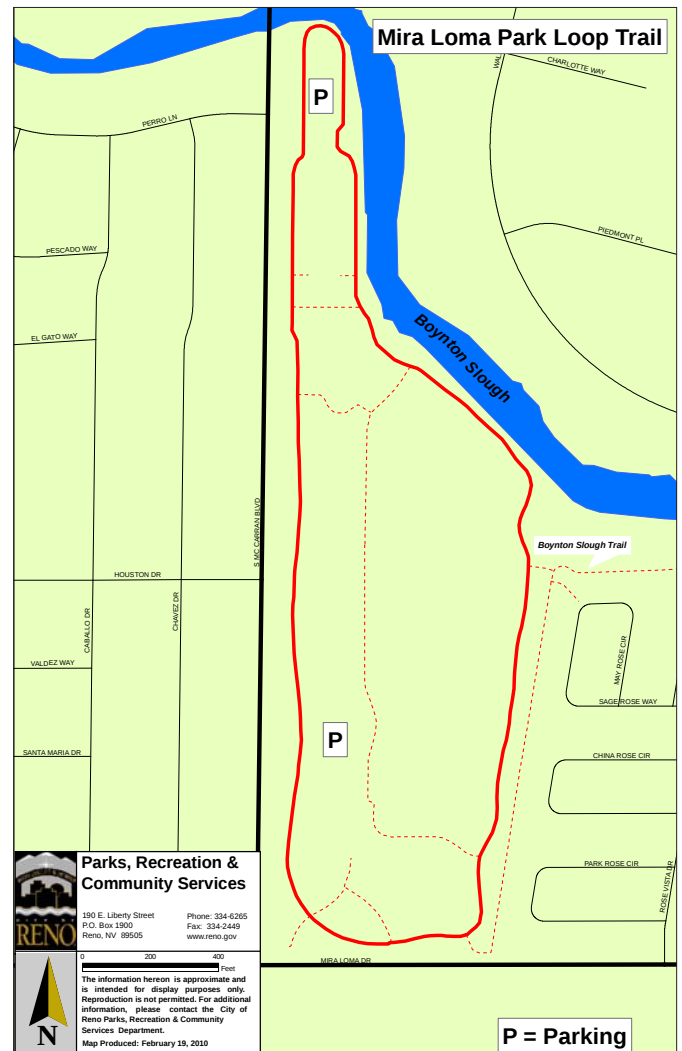


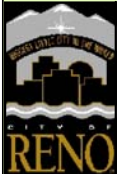
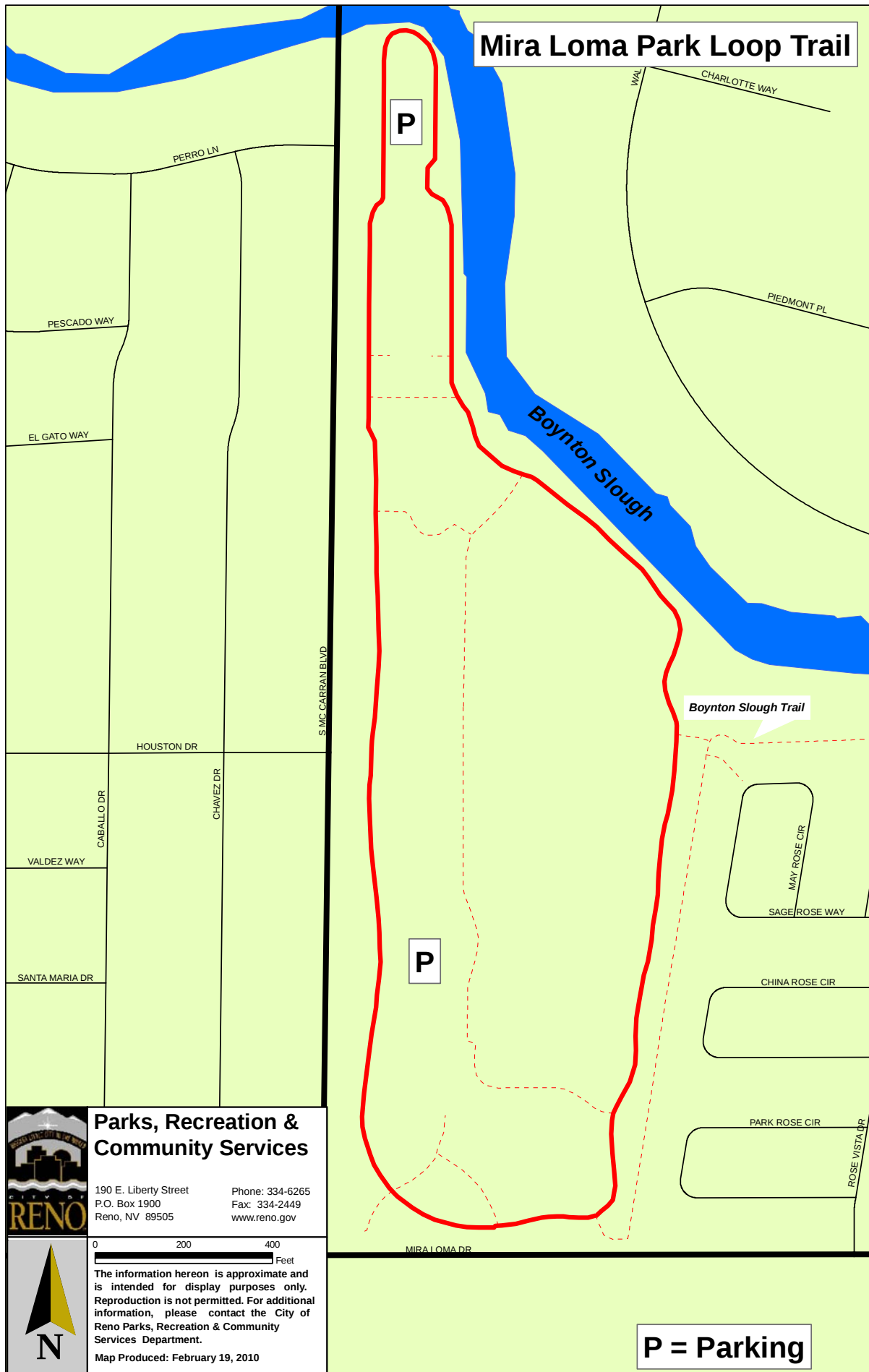
MIRA LOMA URBAN TRAIL

The Mira Loma Urban Trail encompasses one of the area's parks with the greatest assortment of amenities and facilities including fitness courses along the trail, sports fields, a playground, picnic areas and restrooms. Mira Loma Park also has the area's largest skatepark with several bowls, halfpipes, rails, and funboxes for skateboarders, rollerskaters and BMX riders to develop their skills. Follow the water's edge along the northeastern part of the loop where Boynton Slough meets Mira Loma Park.
