2017 COURT OF THE YEAR

On Wednesday, June 13, 2018, the Reno Municipal Court received the 2017 Court of the Year award presented by Nevada Association of Court Executives (NACE) President Randall Soderquist. This honor is bestowed annually on a Nevada court that utilizes best practices to develop, implement, and benchmark innovative and efficient processes that result in the effective delivery of judicial services both to the general public and their stakeholders.

The Reno Municipal Court implemented the following services in 2017:

Technology: Launched a texting service to remind defendants of upcoming court dates or fine payment dates, online access to request new court dates and for implementation of the electronic DMV conviction reporting.

Specialty Courts: Obtained funding to maintain existing programs as well as launch new programs aimed at reducing recidivism and increasing public safety through intensive behavioral supervision, judicial monitoring, and treatment of substance abusers.
