Standard Inspection Fee (per hour)	\$ 81.00	
Recurring Inspections on businesses that require an Operational Permit		Fire Prevention Bureau will perform inspections on occupancies that require a "permit". The fee for any permit will be \$98 and the occupancy will be billed for each permit (stack permit fees). The Permit fee is separate from the hourly inspection rate. Should violations occur, the first re-inspection will not generate a fee, but subsequent inspections will be charged at \$81 per hour with a minimum 1 hour.
