Pursuant to NRS 241.020(6), supporting material is made available to the general public at the same time it is provided to the public body.

<u>Order of Business:</u> The presiding officer shall determine the order of the agenda and all questions of parliamentary procedure at the meeting. Items on the agenda may be taken out of order. The public body may combine two or more agenda items for consideration, remove an item from the agenda, or delay discussion relating to an item on the agenda at any time. See NRS 241.020(2)(c)(6). Items scheduled to be heard at a specific time will be heard no earlier than the stated time but may be heard later.

<u>Public Comment:</u> No action may be taken on a matter raised under general public comment until the matter is included on an agenda as an item on which action may be taken. Public comment, whether on items listed on the agenda or general public comment, is limited to three (3) minutes per person. Unused time may not be reserved by the speaker, nor allocated to another speaker.

Pursuant to Section 2 of Directive 006 and Section 23 of Directive 018, members of the public may submit public comment by emailing castillot@reno.gov or leaving a voicemail at 775-393-1768. Comments received prior to 4:00 p.m. on the day before the meeting will be transcribed and provided to the public body in advance of the meeting for review and entered into the record. During the meeting, members of the public may submit public comments by emailing castillot@reno.gov or may provide public comment by participating in the teleconference. All comments received by the end of the public comment period during the meeting will be provided to the committee for review prior to adjournment and entered into the record.

The presiding officer may prohibit comment if the content of the comments is a topic that is not relevant to, or within the authority of, the public body, or if the content is willfully disruptive of the meeting by being irrelevant, repetitious, slanderous, offensive, inflammatory, irrational, or amounting to personal attacks or interfering with the rights of other speakers. See Nevada Attorney General Opinion No. 00-047 (April 27, 2001); Nevada Open Meeting Law Manual, § 7.05.
