

Costs & Fees

At Players North Soccer Club, one of our goals is to offer a comprehensive youth soccer program at a reasonable price for a player's family.

Our club membership fee is \$500 per year (averages less than \$42 a month). All fees for participation in Players North Soccer Club can be paid in monthly installments. Club membership provides access to Academy training sessions, Club Training staff, Goalkeeper sessions, Winter Training Sessions, College Advisory Program, College Bound Seminars, Club Sponsored Clinics and the Best Practice Fields in town. A portion of the club fees collected are allocated to Coach Education and Player Scholarships.

Competitive League registration ranges from \$32 to 36 per player for the year. Field Fees are \$50 per season per player. Referee fees are paid at the fields for Home Games.

Team Training Fees, Tournament Deposits and Indoor Deposits vary team to team. Please consult the Head Coach for more information for individual teams.

GBYSL Recreational League registration is \$120 per season per player.

US Club Registration is \$25 annually.

New players to the club are required to purchase a Players North uniform kit. Information on uniform pricing will be provided to players invited to register with the club.
