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I PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to provide equal lane allocation for swim teams using City of Reno pools.

II PERSONS AFFECTED

All City of Reno aquatic staff.

III POLICY

Lane allocation will primarily be equally distributed among the following teams:

Due to extreme pool space limitation, no new swim teams will be allowed to use City of Reno pools.

IV DEFINITIONS

Lane Hour – calculated as 60 minutes per lane in a pool. If there are 8 lanes in a pool, and the pool is available for 2 hours, then there are 16 lane hours available.

Prime Time – lane usage from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm at all City of Reno pools.

Resident – individuals living within City of Reno limits. A Reno address does not necessarily mean the individual is a resident. Residency will be verified by City staff. Business addresses will not qualify as residency unless the business is owned by the legal guardian.

Segments – specified time periods for competitive lap swim or water polo.

^{*}During the months of April, September and October, due to the icy conditions on the pool deck and cold morning weather with temperatures near or below freezing, Idlewild Pool will only be available in the afternoon on the weekdays and will open later on the weekends. This is needed to prevent staff from lifeguarding in temperatures that put their health at risk and not being "rescue ready" due to the need to have multiple layers of clothing in order to stay warm.

V PROCEDURES

- 1. Prior to the start of the fall/winter and spring/summer seasons, the swim teams shall submit their swim team pool space rental request form to the Recreation Supervisor.
- 2. The total number of lane hours will be divided equally among the teams.
 - a. For lap swim:
 - i. If there are 400 lane hours, each team will initially receive 100 lane hours each.
 - b. For water polo:
 - i. If there are 24 lane hours, each team will initially receive 12 lane hours each.
- 3. Should a team not require all of their allocation the hours will be equally distributed again among the remaining teams needing additional time.
 - a. If 3 teams request all 100 lane hours, and 1 team requests 25 lane hours, the remaining 10 hours will be split 3-ways (25 hours per team).
- 4. The process will repeat until no remaining hours are left.
- 5. Each team has equal rights to **prime time** lane hours and distribution will be the same as described above.
- 6. For practical reasons, teams may choose to modify their hours after a group discussion with all teams and agreement is reached.
- 7. No team has grandfathered usage; the lane allocation process will reset each season.
- 8. If a dispute arises, lane allocation will be determined by the average number of users per team over the prior three months of regular use.
 - a. City of Reno staff will track the monthly use of swimmers based on the following data points:
 - i. Number of hours the pool is used by a swim team.
 - ii. Average number of swimmers per hour in the pool.
 - iii. Total estimated number of "splash count". This number is calculated by multiplying the hours of use with the average number of swimmers.
 - b. The percentage of swimmers in the pool based on "splash count" will determine the number of lane hours to be allocated. Total size of team will not be used to determine the number of lane hours.
