Lane Allocation Changes



- PROPOSED CHANGE #1 (Programming Hours)
 - Maintains current operating times at Northwest Pool and Idlewild Pool
 - Public use of the pool is not increased nor decreased.
 - Elimination of Traner Pool hours
 - Pool was not used by teams
 - No lane lines
 - Inclusion of Idlewild Pool early opening/late closure hours
 - April, September, October (Due to colder temperatures)
 - Eliminates swimming prior to 8:00am on the weekends
 - No early mornings allow for staff and swimmer safety (ice, steam)
 - Ability to open early/close later is weather dependent.

Lane Allocation Changes



- PROPOSED CHANGE #2 (Allocation Dispute)
 - Initial allocation process remains the same
 - Teams all split time and hours evenly.
 - ie. 400 hours / 4 teams = 100 lane hours each.
 - Previous Dispute Policy
 - Based on residency.
 - Rosters would be submitted. Percentages of COR residents on rosters.
 - Lanes determined based on percentages. 50% of residents = 50% of lanes.
 - Proposed Dispute Policy
 - Based on actual usage.
 - City staff tracks average number of swimmers per team. “Splash Count”
 - Allocation determined based on % of swimmers in the pool.
