

COMMUNITY SNAPSHOT: GAINESVILLE, FL

- County population 270,000
- Warm weather, good services, college town
- Roughly 800 people without housing, down 36% since 2014
- 68% reduction in unsheltered homelessness since 2014
- Ongoing attempts to solve homelessness
- Established GRACE and "Dignity Village" in 2014

GRACE

A TALE OF TWO HOMELESS CAMPS: DIGNITY VILLAGE

- Started in 2014 preceding closure of large downtown homeless camp
- Insufficient services and staffing goal was simply to provide a place
 to go and a "solution" to Pottinger
 issues
- Approx. \$400,000 investment annually

OUTCOMES

- Population jumped to 300
- No verified housing outcomes
- A "chronic homelessness factory"
- 3-4 EMS/Fire Rescue responses daily
- Ongoing problems with violence

A TALE OF TWO HOMELESS CAMPS: GRACE Camp

- Opened March 2, 2020 as part of the Dignity Village closure
- 90 people on campground
- Strong housing focus
- Controlled ingress/egress
- Key piece of plan that led to a 90% roster reduction

OUTCOMES TO DATE:

- DV closed with zero arrests
- 129 people housed
- 38% decrease in unsheltered PIT
- 90% housing retention rate
- 8/10 average score on questions about respect and support

DIGNITY VILLAGE: PROJECT TIMELINE

3/2/2020

On-site campground opens Dignity Village closed

Original 6-month goal: 50% reduction

12-month goal: 80% reduction

24-month goal: 100% reduction



12 months after Dignity Village closed:

- We have reduced the roster by 89%
- 129 people have been housed
- 25 remain to be housed
