






Shelter Usage

Key Updates

Safety

- Additional security officers.
- Fencing installation for central ingress/egress.
- Guard shack in place for campus check-in, in addition to shelter check-in.

Access

- Showers, day use areas, and daily meals accessible for all community members.
- Additional sani-huts and handwashing stations on campus.

Health

- Coordinating mobile COVID-19 vaccination clinic.
- Looking for additional pet vaccination options.
- Shift workers section added to the shelter.
- Shaded areas for guests and pets completed.

Single Women and Couples

- Accommodating single women and couples.
- Couples with pets are welcome.

Ongoing Collaboration

- Finalizing Interlocal Cooperative Agreement for Shelter Operations, City of Reno, City of Sparks, and Washoe County (CHAB Agenda Item 10)
