Public Comment: No action may be taken on a matter raised under general public comment until the matter is included on a subsequent agenda as an action item. Public comment is limited to three (3) minutes per person, and will be taken at the beginning and end of the meeting. Members of the public may submit public comment by leaving a voicemail at (775) 334-3104 prior to 12:00 pm on the day before the meeting or by emailing them to taylor@reno.gov. Messages received prior to 12:00 pm on the day before the meeting will be transcribed, provided to the OPEB Board for review, and entered into the record. During the meeting, members of the public may submit public comment without being physically present by emailing taylor@reno.gov or clicking on the meeting link and following the directions given. Public comment received during the meeting will be provided to the OPEB Board for review prior to adjournment and entered into the record.

The presiding officer may prohibit comment if the content of comments is a topic that is not relevant to, or within the authority of, the public body, or if the content is willfully disruptive of the meeting by being irrelevant, repetitious, slanderous, offensive, inflammatory, irrational or amounting to personal attacks or interfering with the rights of other speakers. Any person making willfully disruptive remarks while addressing the public body or while attending the meeting may be removed from the room by the presiding officer, See, NRS 241.030(4)(a). and the person may be barred from further audience before the public body during that session. See, Nevada Attorney General Opinion No. 00-047 (April 27, 2001); *Nevada Open Meeting Law Manual*, § 8.05.

Examples of disruptive conduct include, without limitation, yelling, stamping of feet, whistles, applause, heckling, name calling, use of profanity, personal attacks, physical intimidation, threatening use of physical force, assault, battery, or any other acts intended to impede the meeting or infringe on the rights of the public body or meeting participants.

Order of Business: The presiding officer shall determine the order of the agenda and all questions of parliamentary procedure at the meeting. Items on the agenda may be taken out of order. The public body may combine two or more agenda items for consideration; remove an item from the agenda; or delay discussion relating to an item on the agenda at any time. See NRS 241.020(3)(d)(6). Items scheduled to be heard at a specific time will be heard no earlier than the stated time, but may be heard later.
