Safe Camp at Governor's Bowl



Pre-approval process aimed at:

- Targeting Unsheltered individuals:
 - Work towards a housing plan
 - Not comfortable with congregate shelter.
- Maintaining the ability to be flexible and address changing needs.

Pre-approval process aimed to avoid:

- A large waiting list as people may be resistant to accepting other options of housing.
- Individuals to travel across town with all their belongings to find out the safe camp is full.
