The presiding officer may prohibit comment if the content of the comments is a topic that is not relevant to, or within the author by, or if the content is willfully disruptive of the meeting by being irrelevant, repetitious, slanderous, offensive, inflamma y, irrational or amounting to personal attacks or interfering with the rights of other speakers. Any person making will disrupti remarks while addressing or while attending may be removed from the room by the presiding officer and the person make d from further audience. In addition, any person valfully discretify the meeting may be removed from the room by the presiding officer. See NRS 241.030(4)(a); RMC §§ 8.12.024, 8.12.27. Examples of disruptive conduct include, without limitation, yelling, stamping of feet, whistles, applause, heckling, name calling, use of profactly, personal attacks, physical intimidation, threatening use of physical force, assault, battery, or any other acts intended to impede the meeting or infringe on the rights of this body, city staff, or meeting participants.
