Project Description & Purpose

The purpose of this project is to remodel the former RGJ newspaper building for into the new Reno Public Safety Center (PSC). The Reno Police Station at 455 E 2nd St is over 70 years old, overcapacity, and needs major repairs that are estimated to cost more than the value of the building. The PSC will bring many community service divisions into one location, including RPD headquarters, Evidence, Mobile Outreach Safety Team, Senior Auxiliary Volunteer Effort, Victim Advocates, and other divisions. The PSC will be able to better serve the public in a safe and secure facility.
