Public Comment: No action may be taken on a matter raised under general public comment until the matter is included on a subsequent agenda as an action item. Public comment is limited to three (3) minutes per person, and will be taken at the beginning and end of the meeting. Members of the public may submit public comment by leaving a voicemail at (775) 334-2578 prior to 8:00 am on the day of the meeting or by emailing them to housing@reno.gov. Messages received prior to 8:00 am on the day of the meeting will be transcribed, provided to the Washoe County HOME Consortium Directors for review, and entered into the record. During the meeting, members of the public may submit public comment without being physically present by emailing <a href="mailto:housing@reno.gov">housing@reno.gov</a> or clicking on the meeting link and following the directions given. Public comment received during the meeting will be provided to the Washoe County HOME Consortium Directors for review prior to adjournment and entered into the record.

The presiding officer may prohibit comment if the content of comments is a topic that is not relevant to, or within the authority of, the public body, or if the content is willfully disruptive of the meeting by being irrelevant, repetitious, slanderous, offensive, inflammatory, irrational or amounting to personal attacks or interfering with the rights of other speakers. Any person making willfully disruptive remarks while addressing the public body or while attending the meeting may be removed from the room by the presiding officer, and the person may be barred from further audience before the public body during that session. See NRS 241.030(4)(a), Nevada Attorney General Opinion No. 00-047 (April 27, 2001); Nevada Open Meeting Law Manual, § 7.06.

Examples of disruptive conduct include, without limitation, yelling, stamping of feet, whistles, applause, heckling, name calling, use of profanity, personal attacks, physical intimidation, threatening use of physical force, assault, battery, or any other acts intended to impede the meeting or infringe on the rights of the public body or meeting participants.

Accommodations: The Washoe County HOME Consortium Directors and staff will make reasonable efforts to assist and accommodate persons with physical disabilities desiring to attend the meeting.
