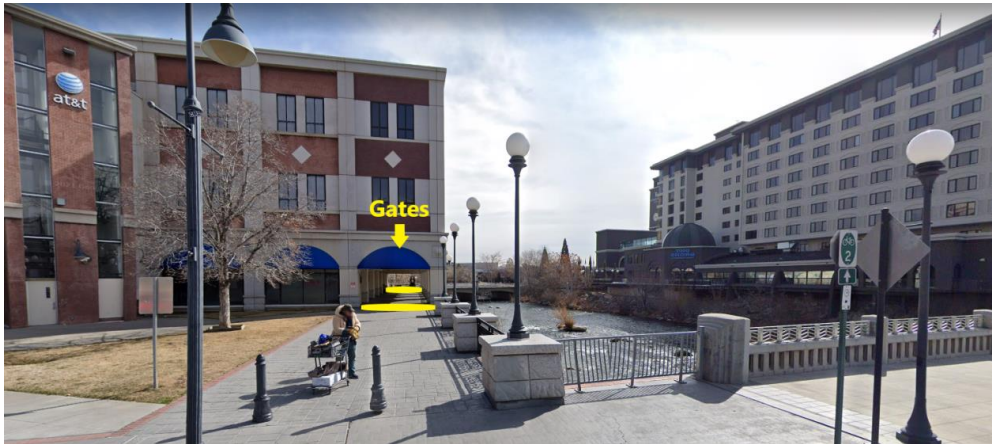

**SUBJECT:** AT&T Building Gate Installation

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The City of Reno established an easement agreement in July 2000 for pedestrian access along the river walk at the AT&T building, located at 10 N. Center Street. Due to ongoing public health and safety concerns and activity beneath the building adjacent the Truckee River, including fires, the AT&T managers and the Renaissance Downtown Hotel expressed concerns.

In coordination with Clean and Safe and the Downtown Reno Partnership (DRP), AT&T installed gates on both ends of its property along the river walk. Similar to the downtown ReTRAC Plaza, DRP ambassadors will unlock the gates at 7:30 a.m. for public access and lock the gates at 7:30 p.m., 7 days a week.



This walkway is part of the Tahoe-Pyramid Trail. Staff contacted the Tahoe-Pyramid Trail about ongoing concerns. They understood the need for the installation and were supportive. Detour signage will be added to facilitate redirection.
