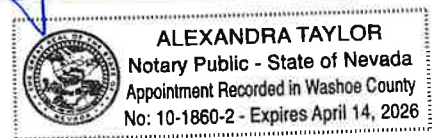



Led the day-to-day operations of the news team including identifying key stories to cover and ensuring they were presented on air in an objective and fair manner. KRNV News 4 was recognized as the top-rated newscast in the market regularly during tenure as News Director. Our News Department also operated without any litigation during this period.
