This submittal is intended to promote public safety and protect all existing facilities within the City of Reno right-of-way. Large-Scale Utility Improvement Projects consisting of more than 500 lineal feet of utility installation or determined by the City as requiring additional review, will require initial and final submittal items due to the City of Reno Public Works. A licensed engineer shall complete the following design requirements prior to receiving an Encroachment and Excavation Permit:

- A complete design plan showing all existing utilities and infrastructure within the proposed construction area must be submitted to the City of Reno for review and acceptance prior to receiving an Encroachment and Excavation Permit (EE Permit). Proposed construction improvement plans must be prepared and stamped by a State of Nevada Licensed Engineer and comply with all applicable regulations and guidelines.
• Plans that fail to accurately depict City of Reno infrastructure will be immediately returned. City of Reno Infrastructure Requests can be made online for any area of the City at: https://www.reno.gov/government/departments/city-clerk/public-records
• Construction plans must provide information showing the location of all surface restoration (asphalt, concrete, landscaping, etc.). Restoration must meet the City of Reno’s Standard Details.

A construction review meeting may be required prior to issuing an EE permit. Incomplete submittals may delay the timely processing of an EE Permit.
