BUDGET MESSAGE

The 2023/2024 Final Budget for the Reno Redevelopment Agency #1 includes total revenues of \$3,749,024 and total expenditures including transfers of \$4,129,000. As in prior years, expenditures have been determined based upon available information at the time of filing the tentative budget. Appropriations do not exceed estimated resources within each fund. Projected ending fund balances for all funds estimated at a level needed and from available information.

The settlement agreement between the Redevelopment Agency and Washoe County ended 6/30/18.

The Agency currently holds property for re-sale, which is reflected in the beginning and ending fund balances.
