SUBJECT: Electric Heat Pumps for Rehabilitated Homes Pilot Project Grant Outcomes

On June 27, 2023, Staff closed out a one-year grant from the Urban Sustainability Directors Network. The grant funded a heat pump pilot project in underserved communities. Attached is a summary of outcomes.

Due to the success of the program, Staff is actively seeking additional funds to continue providing electric heat pumps for citizens in need.




HOMES WITH HEAT EXPOSURE & ENERGY BURDEN
