**SUBJECT:** Draft FY 2024/2025 Fee Schedule

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The City of Reno is inviting Boards and Commissions to review the attached fee schedules and provide comment to the City Manager's Office by April 15, 2024. Please submit comments to Barbara DiCianno by emailing [diciannob@reno.gov](mailto:diciannob@reno.gov).

As part of the budget process, staff analyzed and updated the City's comprehensive list of fees and charges for services, applying 3.6 percent consumer price index (CPI) to applicable fees. Not all fees will be increased by CPI due to market rates or fees established under Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS). For example, fees in Municipal Court have no change. Overall, there were minimal changes in fees as a result of the annual adjustment by CPI to applicable fees. Other changes include new fees, fee changes, and fee increases. Notable changes are outlined below.

The Building Permit Valuation fee table and Building Mechanical/Plumbing/Electrical (MP&E) tables are published annually by the International Code Council (ICC). The ICC has not published the current fee tables for this cycle. The Building Valuation Table and Building – MPE table in the City's Fee Schedule will be updated to reflect the ICC tables once those are published.
