BASICS: Shuffleboard will be held at the above address. Participants will be divided into groups: Men, Women and Mixed doubles and Age based on the number of entries.

SHUFFLEBOARD GAME PLAY

- 1) At the beginning of the game, a coin will be tossed. The winning team/individual will decide whether they want to use the yellow discs (taking the first turn) or the black discs (taking the second turn) or giving each team a number and using the tier method for order of play.
- 2) The yellow team will go first starting on the right of the board and alternate taking turns with the black team. Each team has 4 discs. Once the discs have been sent (4 discs per team), the points will be tallied and marked. After the 4th pitch, the team that went second will start first using the yellow discs on the right of the shuffleboard and continue 8th pitch.
- 3) When taking your shot, participants must stand behind the -10 line on your half of the triangle and your discs must be in the section of the triangle labeled "-10".
- 4) Your goal is to send your disc into the triangle at the opposite side of the mat. In order to earn a point, it must be inside of the triangle completely and touch no lines. If you shoot your disc too far off the back of the board or your disc lands on a line, no points will be earned. If you do not shoot your disc far enough (if it lands in the middle or doesn't cross both lines) your disc will be removed from the board.
- 5) You may use your discs to shoot the other team's discs off the board and put yourself in scoring position.

SCORING: If less than 10 participants - game ends at 8 pitches If more than 10 participants - game ends at 50 points

Participants with the highest score by Team and Age will be winner
