The blackjack event will follow standard rules for blackjack tournaments. Blackjack will not be broken down by age or gender. All players will be playing in one group.

The object of the game of blackjack is to get a hand that is a higher total than the dealers, but which does not exceed twenty-one. Players are playing against the dealer, but they are also playing against the other players at the table.

Number cards count for face value, i.e. a 2 is worth 2 and a 5 is worth 5; face cards count as 10; aces can be counted as a 1 or an 11.

To win a table/round, the player must have the highest dollar value of chips at the end of the round.

Rules:

- 1. Players will receive a set value of chips to start.
- 2. Maximum bets will equal the opening bankroll amount.
- 3. Players must bet the minimum before cards are dealt. Bets must be stacked.
- 4. A player may double down on any two cards player receives **one card** only when doubling down.
- 5. A player may split any two cards with equal value. A player may re-split up to four times except aces that can only be split once. A player may get multiple hits (cards) when for split cards.
- 6. Number of rounds will be determined by number of entries. Number of hands dealt will be determined by the host.
- 7. Tournament Host will settle any disputes.

There will be two sets of round winners (gold, silver & bronze). The overall champion will be the player with the highest single round total.
