Staff was asked to track important matters before the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada. The following dockets are matters in which the City should be aware and take action as indicated.

### **Docket No. 24-05023**

**Date Opened:** 05/21/2024

**Description:** Application of SPPC, filed under Advice Letter No. 674-E, to implement Clean Transition Tariff Schedule No. CTT to allow eligible customers to receive bundled electric service from new clean energy

resources.

**Status:** Application filed.

**Impact:** This proposed tariff applies to SPPC's fully bundled large retail customers with 5MW or more, and is stated to provide a path for existing customers to remain a retail customer while transitioning to an energy

supply agreement to meet corporate sustainability goals

**Recommended Action:** Monitor and reach out to NV Energy.

**Date Opened:** 03/01/2024

Description: Joint Application of NPC and SPPC for approval of the cost recovery of the regulatory assets

relating to the development and implementation of their Joint Natural Disaster Protection Plan.

cost recovery,

**Description:** Application of NPC for approval of fuel and purchased power expenses, to reset the Temporary Renewable Energy Development charge, reset all components of the Renewable Energy Program Rate, reset the Base Energy Efficiency Program Rates, reset the Base Energy Efficiency Implementation Rates, reset the Energy Efficiency Program Amortization Rate, reset the Energy Efficiency Implementation Amortization Rate, reset the Expanded Solar Program Costs Rate.
