

# PLACES OF ASSEMBLY



## OPERATIONAL PERMIT INFORMATION SHEET

This Permit issued and accepted on condition that all provisions of the Codes now adopted, or that may hereafter be adopted, shall be complied with.

- Decorative materials shall not be made from combustible material unless they have been treated and maintained with an approved flame-retardant product.
- Direct and unobstructed access to all exits shall be provided. Exit number, location, and size shall be as approved by both the building and fire codes.
- When move-able chairs are used, such chairs shall be securely fastened together in banks of not less than six chairs and shall be constructed of such material and so designed as to not collapse or to block aisles in case of an emergency.
- Fixed fire systems shall be provided and maintained as approved during the plans review process.
- Approved fire extinguishers shall be provided and maintained as specified by the Reno Fire Department.
- A placard indicating the capacity of any room in number of occupants shall be posted.
- It is unlawful to smoke on the main floor, backstage, in any dressing room, change room, storage room, or basement, in any theater, or motion picture theater unless otherwise approved by the Reno Fire Department.
- The Reno Fire Department must be notified 48 hours in advance of the use of any use of a place of assembly, other than the use of a motion picture theater for their regular performances.
- Places of Assembly must comply with all applicable provisions of the 2018 International Fire Code and Section 16.30 of the Reno Municipal Code. Additional requirements are subject to inspection and review.

The applicant accepts responsibility for the use of this Permit, in full compliance with the terms and conditions above, and additionally hereby to assume, pay and hold the City of Reno harmless for any liability arising out of the Permit. This Permit does not take the place of any license required by law and is not transferable. Any change in the use or occupancy of premises shall require a new permit.
