

Special Amusement Buildings



OPERATIONAL PERMIT INFORMATION SHEET

This Permit issued and accepted on condition that all provisions of the Codes now adopted, or that may hereafter be adopted, shall be complied with.

- An approved automatic extinguishing system must be provided and maintained.
- An approved automatic detection system must be provided and maintained.
- Activation of any single detector or the automatic sprinkler system shall immediately sound an alarm at a constantly attended location in the building.
- The activation of two or more detectors, a single detector with alarm verification or the automatic sprinkler system shall automatically:
 - Cause the means of egress signage to light. Not less than 1 foot-candle at the walking surface level must be provided
 - Stop any confusing sounds and visual distractions
 - Activate an approved directional exit marking that will become apparent in an emergency.
- System response shall also include activation of a prerecorded message which is clearly audible throughout the building, instructing patrons to proceed to the nearest exit. Alarm signals shall be distinctive from other sounds used during normal operations.
- The wiring to the auxiliary devices and equipment used to accomplish these fire safety functions shall be monitored.
- An emergency voice/alarm communication system shall be installed in accordance with NFPA 72 and shall be audible throughout the entire building.
- Special amusement buildings must comply with all applicable provisions of the 2018 International Fire Code. Additional requirements are subject to inspection and review.

The applicant accepts responsibility for the use of this Permit, in full compliance with the terms and conditions above, and additionally hereby to assume, pay and hold the City of Reno harmless for any liability arising out of the Permit. This Permit does not take the place of any license required by law and is not transferable. Any change in the use or occupancy of premises shall require a new permit.
