OPERATIONAL PERMIT INFORMATION SHEET

This Permit issued and accepted on condition that all provisions of the Codes now adopted, or that may hereafter be adopted, shall be complied with.

- No open burning, smoking, cutting, welding, or operation of heating devices will be allowed.
- A copy of the approved fire safety plan shall be posted and maintained at the yard.
- Individual piles shall not exceed 5,000 square feet, 50,000 cubic feet in volume or 10 feet in height.
- Individual piles shall be separated from each other by a clear space of 40 feet and shall be 50 feet from lot lines and buildings.
- Yards storing more than 150,000 cubic yards in bulk shall increase separation distance between piles to 75 feet.
- Storage shall not be under electrical power lines, bridges, elevated trestles, roadways, or railroads.
- Yards shall be maintained free from grass and weeds for 40 feet from stored material and 100 feet from brush and forested areas.
- Yards storing more than 20,000 cubic feet must provide and maintain an approved fence.
- The gate shall be 20 feet unobstructed clear width and shall be locked when the yard is unattended.
- Fire department access roadways shall be provided to within 150 feet of any portion of the yard and to within 20 feet of all piles.
- Approved fire extinguishers must be provided and maintained in buildings and vehicles.
- Tire storage yards must comply with all applicable provisions of the 2018 International Fire Code and NFPA 230. Additional requirements are subject to inspection and review.

The applicant accepts responsibility for the use of this Permit, in full compliance with the terms and conditions above, and additionally hereby to assume, pay and hold the City of Reno harmless for any liability arising out of the Permit. This Permit does not take the place of any license required by law and is not transferable. Any change in the use or occupancy of premises shall require a new permit.
