SUBJECT: Truckee River Plan Request for Qualifications (RFQ) Scope and Timeline

On March 8, 2023, Council approved \$3 million of State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds received through the American Rescue Plan Act to invest in the Truckee River Experience. On July 12, 2023, the City and County released the <u>Truckee River Plan RFQ</u> for a consultant to develop a cohesive plan for the Truckee River.

The purpose of the plan is to conduct an analysis of the Truckee River corridor and adjacent land within unincorporated Washoe County and City of Reno from the California State Line to the border of Sparks, and develop an implementation and financing plan to guide current and future investment. In addition to working with the City of Reno staff, the consultant will work with the public and stakeholders to identify a unified vision and provide recommendations and a phased implementation plan.

The scope includes:

- 1. Land Use & Design
 - Establishes land use and design policies
 - Identifies future land use and circulation patterns
 - Develops a historic resources strategy
 - Establishes an arts and culture strategy
 - Encourages economic development
 - Establishes design standards
- 2. Micromobility & Connectivity
 - Establishes mobility goals and policies
 - Promotes connectivity and accessibility
 - Identifies pedestrian and bicycle improvements
 - Identifies transit improvements

- 3. Parks & Open Space
 - Establishes parks and open space policies
 - Identifies park improvements
 - Identifies greenway trail improvements
 - Improves trail accessibility and wayfinding consistency
 - Identifies river access and recreation improvements
- 4. Safety & Sustainability
 - Establishes safety policies
 - Develops a natural resources/sustainability strategy
 - Identifies lighting improvements
 - Addresses river obstacles and safe river access
 - Improves cleanliness in and along the river corridor
 - Improves patrol strategies
