Please find the attached 2024 Q3 (July 1 – September 30) Report for Bird.

Report Highlights:

• Total Rides: **65,435**

• Revenue Generated for the City: \$17,013.10

• Metric Tons of CO2 Avoided: 3.242

• Number of Fines Issued: 96 (up 9 fines from last quarter)

• Number of Repeat Offenders: 50 (up 23 from last quarter)

• Total Vehicles in Service: **677**

City of Reno 2024 Q3 Quarterly Report City Staff Supplement

- Reno Direct received **38** calls this quarter related to Bird e-Scooters. Majority of those calls were complaints regarding scooters being parked in inappropriate spaces, and one email voiced concern over the numbers reported in the original Q2 report, before amendments were made.
- Bird engaged in two different community events this quarter:
 - o **Dancing in the Streets 7/13/2024 MidTown:** Bird promoted the event in their app and offered riders \$5 off their ride, with almost 350 people taking advantage of the promotion.
 - Reno Startup Week 9/16 9/20: Supported as the Transportation sponsor for the week. Bird promised and delivered consistent deployment of 20-25 vehicles at the Innovation Center and The Paloma/The Basement for attendees. Additionally, Bird offered a \$5 promo to all attendees.





Redistribution Activities (Summary)	FMs receive "out of nest" and "out of compliance" alerts for vehicles parked outside of corrals. They prioritize these alerts and rebalance vehicles into nests several times daily.
